

HOW TO RUN VFD UNDER X64 SYSTEMS

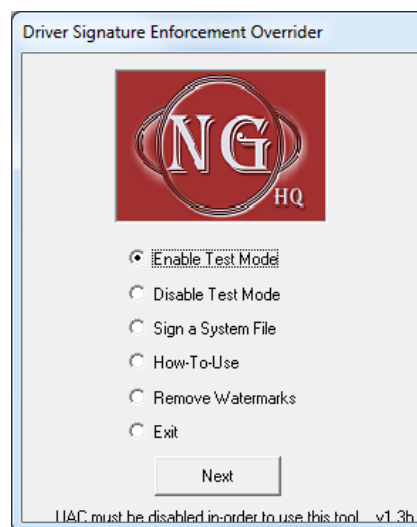
Problem: VFD requires a kernel mode driver, *vfd.sys*, but *vfd.sys* is an unsigned and uncertified driver

Solution: You have to enable unsigned/uncertified driver loading under your x64 Windows system

[Enable loading] – Step 1:

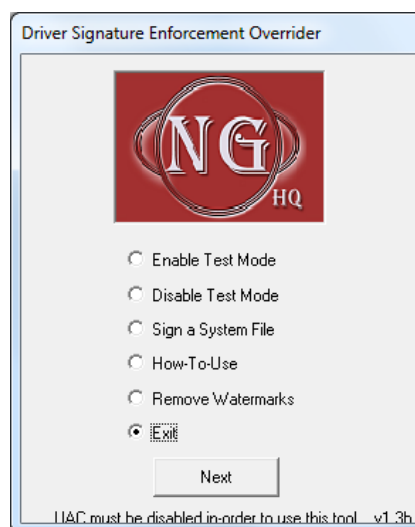
1.1) Run  dseo13b.exe

1.2) Set *Enable Test Mode*, and press NEXT



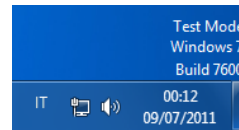
1.3) Set *Exit* and press NEXT

1.4) Close Windows and restart the system



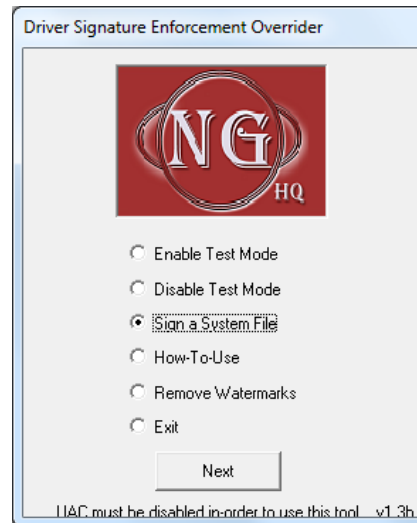
[Enable vfd.sys] – Step 2:

- 2.1) Now Windows should be in Test Mode: check for the logo in the bottom right corner of the desktop

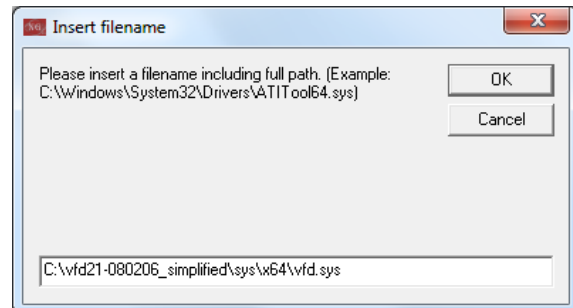


- 2.2) Run  dseo13b.exe

- 2.3) Set *Sign a System File* and press NEXT



- 2.4) Enter the vfd.sys (x64 version) path



- 2.5) Set *Exit* and press NEXT

- 2.6) Close Windows and restart the system

- 2.7) Now Windows is ready to run VFD in *Administrator Mode*
