

# vDos: Run DOS applications in Windows\_

The new vDos versions are a little less freeware: vDos will check if the PC is joined to a domain, or files on a networked drive are addressed. In such a situation a popup is displayed, so vDos has become sort of nagware for some targeted business users. Still being freeware, one can just ignore the eventual nag. Certainly if vDos isn't used that often, this shouldn't pose a real obstacle.

If you don't like this, you can of course still download the older versions and source codes of vDos at SourceForge.
